



Exclusion Procedures

Review: July 2021

Exclusion procedures followed are in line with the Department for Education (DfE) guidance – “Exclusions from maintained schools, Academies and pupil referral units in England”.

In cases of serious misbehaviour, the Headteacher, or in his/her absence the Deputy Headteacher, will exclude a student for either a fixed term or permanently.

In the case of a permanent exclusion the school will convene a Directors Disciplinary Panel to meet with parent/s and the Headteacher and/or Deputy Headteacher.

Any child who has received a fixed-term exclusion will be expected to attend a re-admission meeting with her/his parents and a member of the Senior Leadership Group.

At this meeting clear targets will be set, along with the appropriate support package to help the student achieve a successful reintegration into school.
